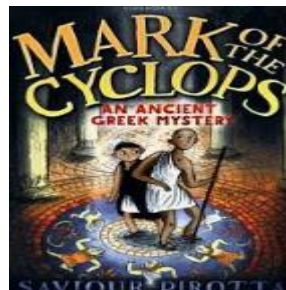
Open up to find out more...
