## Your Child Will Be Learning...

- About who lived in the community during Victorian times.
- How the local area has been influenced by the Victorians.
- What Victorian schooling was like.
- About the British architect, Arthur Wakerley by going on a walking tour of the local area.
- About William Morris, a Victorian artist.
- Formal written methods for the four operations and reasoning skills (maths).
- Dissolving and non-reversible chemical changes (science).

## As part of this topic we will be ...

Reading Street Child, a book set in the 1860s about a boy called Jim.

The children will have the opportunity to go on a walking tour of the local area with Jo (from Historic England) to learn about John Merrick.



We will go on the Wakerley Trail in July.

## How you can help at home...

- talk with your child about what they have been learning in school.
- visit the local library to borrow non-fiction books about the Victorian era.
- On your walk to school, see if you can spot any Victorian houses/dates.

### On-going....

- If they don't already know them, encourage your child to learn their times tables by heart up to 12 x 12. Each child has a log in for TT Rock Stars to help.
- Encourage your child to read for 10 to 20 minutes each day.
- Help your child to learn their weekly spellings / practise spellings for Year 5 on Spelling Frame.
